

NEW - Water Shortage Information for All Water Users

The Town of Longboat Key is currently under new Modified Phase I Watering Restrictions. A "Phase I" declaration means that rainfall and groundwater conditions are below normal and warrant attention. *Do your part by:*

- Reducing indoor water use.
- Testing and repairing or adjusting each irrigation systems to address broken pipes and other leaks, damaged or tilted sprinkler heads, and other sources of water waste.
- Continuing to follow applicable year-round water conservation measures. **The Town's once-per-week lawn watering schedule remains in place.** Watering days and times can be found at www.longboatkey.org/Departments/PublicWorks.
- For those entities with a Water Use Permit, continuing to follow any applicable conditions, including a review of current water conservation programs. (1) assuring that permit-required elements have been fully implemented and (2) determining what additional demand management measures could be reasonably employed, should resource conditions further deteriorate.
