Remember: Don't place recyclables in bags because plastic bags are not accepted. Please flatten any corrugated cardboard and place it at the curb to be collected along with your household garbage.

Your pick-up day for recycling is **Monday**. Please place **both bins** at curbside *before 7:00 AM*. The Town's Recycling Program enables you to recycle these items conveniently at your residence. Labor Day	Solid Waste & Recycling, Saturday, 09/05/09
Thanksgiving Day	Solid Waste, Saturday, 11/28/09
Christmas Day	No change in residential schedule
New Year's Day	No change in residential schedule

*All other holidays will have regular pickup and the hauler will be making collections on their regular schedule.
