Independence Day	No change in residential schedule
Labor Day	Solid Waste & Recycling, TUESDAY, 09/07/10
Thanksgiving Day	Solid Waste, FRIDAY, 11/26/10
Christmas Day	No change in residential schedule
New Year's Day	No change in residential schedule

All other holidays will have regular pickup and the hauler will be making collections on their regular schedule. Look for the reminder notices on your utility bill.
