

92.10 Time restrictions.

All persons and vehicles are prohibited from being present on any public access to the beach within the town and on public property known as Beer Can Island from 11:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m. daily. This section shall not apply to authorized personnel in vehicles, meaning all official, state, county, and town personnel and vehicles engaged in police and fire protection and maintenance duties.

92.11 Possession of alcoholic beverages.

It shall be unlawful for any person to have in his possession, beer, wine, whiskey, or any other alcoholic beverage on any public access to the beach within the town and on public property known as Beer Can Island.

92.12 Prohibited activities.

No person entering on and using the public beach, including public beaches seaward of the mean high-water line and the public beach seaward of the erosion control line, or public beach accesses within the town and public property, including the property known as Beer Can Island, shall do any of the following.

- (A) Build fires other than fires for cooking purposes contained in a grill or stove.
- (B) Throw, place, or deposit any paper, food, trash, cans, bottles, or other refuse.
- (C) Deface, damage, or defile the premises.
- (D) Bring or allow pets on the premises.
- (E) Dress or undress either by changing from ordinary street clothes into bathing or beach attire, or from beach attire into ordinary street clothes on the public beach.
- (F) Bed down on the premises; i.e., after 11:00 p.m. set up tents, shacks, or any other temporary shelter for the purpose of overnight camping.
- (G) Use profane or obscene language or conduct themselves in a disorderly manner.
- (H) Drink, consume, or possess any bottled, canned, or packaged alcoholic beverages.

(I) Use any portion of the public beach where over 10 persons are involved for special events defined in § 92.15(C) without first obtaining written permission from the Town Manager or his designee. The decision to grant such a permit shall be governed by the standards set forth in § 92.15. Such a request shall be made to the town on forms provided by the Town Clerk.

(J) Make any promotional and commercial activities of any kind whatsoever without first obtaining permission from the Town Manager.

92.14 Launching of motor vessels.

Except in an emergency, no motorized vessels shall be brought to the waters of the Gulf of Mexico by bringing them across the beach.
