

- ___ Irrigation system is installed for efficient and effective water use; Section 55.04(A)(6)
- ___ High and Low Irrigation Water Use Zones are operated independently; Section 55.04(A)(6)
- ___ Turfgrass areas, annual flowerbeds, and vegetable gardens are irrigated on separate zones from tree, shrub, and groundcover beds; Section 55.04(A)(6)
- ___ No spray irrigation applied under roof overhangs; Section 55.04(A)(6)
- ___ Where multiple lawn spray heads are used, spray patterns overlap 75%-100%; Section 55.04(A)(7)
- ___ Sprinklers do not spray excessive water unto paved surfaces; Section 55.04(A)(7)
- ___ Pop-up and rotor sprinklers are not mixed in the same irrigation zone; Section 55.04(A)(7)
- ___ Reclaimed or non-potable water is used for irrigation if available (write NA if not available); Section 55.04(A)(8)
- ___ Pump Cycling is minimized via a constant pressure/flow control or a pressure tank for well water sources (write NA if not applicable); Section 55.04(A)(8)
- ___ Micro-irrigation is used for all tree/shrub/groundcover beds, a filter is installed at the head end of the system, and an in-line pressure regulator reduces pressure to no more than 15 psi; Section 55.04(A)(9)
- ___ A functioning rain shutoff device is installed and exposed to unobstructed rainfall per Chapter 53, Section 53.14; Section 55.04(A)(10)
- ___ A landscape maintenance checklist has been provided to the property owner and is displayed next to the irrigation controls; Section 55.04(B)(1) and (3)
- ___ The property owner has been informed of the current irrigation restrictions adopted by the Town of Longboat Key; Section 55.04(B)(1)
- ___ All warranty information on the irrigation system has been provided to the property owner; Section 55.04(B)(2)
- ___ An as-built drawing of the irrigation system is attached and has been provided to the property owner; Section 55.06(A)
